- Overall cumulative 3.50 GPA or higher


Florida Gamma Pi identifies and fosters the academic achievement of radiology students and offers opportunities for individual growth and advancement. It shall


#### Nice Catch!

Recently, Dr. Matteo and interventional radiology team successfully treated a ruptured abdominal aortic aneurysm (AAA) at UF Health North Campus. The patient presented through the North campus ER unstable and complaining of abdominal pain. An urgent CT was performed which showed a large AAA that actively ruptured. As this type of case is not typically performed at North campus, the necessary minimally invasive endovascular devices were not available. However, Dr. Matteo realized that the patient did not have time to be transported to the Downtown campus given the danger and sensitivity of the AAA.

Luckily, Dr. Matteo was able to marshal the resources from industry device reps in the area emergently. The procedure was successfully performed from a bilateral percutaneous minimally invasive femoral approach with assistance from the vascular surgery team. In discussing the team's professionalism, Dr. Matteo remarked that this type of case is a "high stress, high anxiety procedure, which was performed as if it were routine." "The patient was is the right place, at the right time, with the right people." Because of the life-saving intervention, the patient was discharged home from the hospital three days later.

#### <u>Shocking Case :</u>

This patient suffered several stab wounds. You can see that the weapon was stuck. Our caregivers showed courage in the face of the most upsetting traumas.





